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It is so important that Teacher's acknowledge and incorporate the variety of learning styles in their classroom. It is of utter importance for Teacher's to create a positive learning environment for all their students to find success and allowing all learning styles to be acceptable in the classroom is detrimental to this. It may be challenging at times but it is all about thinking outside the box.

Teachers should try to incorporate all learning styles in each of their lessons. This may seem like a hard task but I think would allow for the greatest success for your students. The basic lecture works for your auditory learners and throw some visuals either in a power point or on the smart board and you can be engaging the visual learners. Adding the active component for the kinesthetic learners can be a little tougher challenge to incorporate. It can be as simple though as everyone standing up and asking true or false questions about what was just lectured on. True you stay standing and false you sit down. Also using this as an assessment tool to make sure that you used each teaching strategy effectively trying to incorporate each type of learner into your lesson. Paying attention to the students who maybe struggle with this end assessment activity you can then reflect on how you can better fulfill their learning style next time. It really is all about trial and error for a teacher. There is no way that you will be able to walk into a classroom and just by looking at your students know how each of them learn the best. By strategically planning Teacher's can discover what does and does not work for their students and should be continuously changing up their lessons. Sounds like an exciting challenge to me, keep things interesting!

I am a kinesthetic learner and value the sense of play and being active in the classroom. I understand though that not all students will be able to learn this way though and will have to be aware of not using too much activity in my lessons for the students that are happy to just sit and listen. With time though I think this will be a task I will learn and get better and better at, as practice

makes perfect. Being aware of the diverse ways students learn is so important and I value incorporating each learning style into my lessons as a Teacher.
