Below explains what you need to include in your website, steps to successfully be able to complete your website and how you will be marked.

Pages Needed

1. Home Page: Picture of yourself that shows the true you, quote that you like and short blurb on what your site is for.
2. About Me: Write a paragraph about yourself: where you live, what your family is like, what you like to do as hobbies, what you like to do with your friends, what you would like to do one day. Include photos.
3. Resume: Contact info (Name, phone number, email, website), Education, Employment History, Awards and Honours, Volunteering and Interests.
4. Personal Goals for the future.
5. Career Interests.
6. Hobbies and Interests page.
